



(Biannual Double-Blind Peer Reviewed Refereed E-Journal)

**1. About the Journal**

Kalam's Vision is a blind peer-reviewed refereed, open-access, multidisciplinary and multilingual international e-journal devoted to the publication of original research, review papers, case studies and conceptual articles in all fields.

The journal aims to promote innovative and scholarly research at an international level.

**2. Types of Manuscripts Accepted**

Authors may submit the following types of manuscripts:

- Original research articles
- Review papers
- Case studies
- Conceptual papers
- Short communications
- Book reviews (by invitation only)

**3. Language**

All manuscripts must be written in clear, concise English, Hindi, Urdu, Arabic, Persian etc. but consistency must be maintained throughout the paper.

**4. Manuscript Format**

Manuscripts should be prepared in MS Word format following the guidelines below:

- Font: Times New Roman
- Font size: 12 pt
- Line spacing: 1.15
- Alignment: Justified
- Margin: 1 inch (2.54 cm) on all sides
- Page size: A4
- Maximum length: 6,000 – 8,000 words (including references)

**5. Structure of the Paper**

The paper should be organized in the following order:

- i. Title Page
- ii. Abstract
- iii. Keywords
- iv. Introduction
- v. Literature Review
- vi. Research Methodology

- Clearly state the objective, methodology, major findings and conclusion of the study
- Be written in a single paragraph

## 8. Keywords

Provide 4 – 6 keywords immediately after the abstract, separated by commas.

## 9. Tables, Figures and Images

- Tables and figures must be numbered consecutively (Table 1, Figure 1, etc.)
- Provide a descriptive title for each table/figure
- Source must be mentioned if adapted
- Images should be high resolution (minimum 300 dpi)
